Chennai, Mar 16: The State Assembly was today informed that the fiscal deficit of Tamil Nadu government for 2016-17 will be Rs 61,341 crore, which is 4.58 per cent of the gross state domestic product (GSDP).

TASMAC & STAMP DUTY IMPACT
Jayalalitha said the closing down of 1000 TASMAC shops in 2016 and 2017 will have a significant impact on the State's revenues. The State has registered a negative growth this year in the collection of stamp duty and registration fees and the receipts have been estimated only at Rs 8,200 crore in 2017-18, he said.
